Pancakes, Sausages and Beverages will be provided.



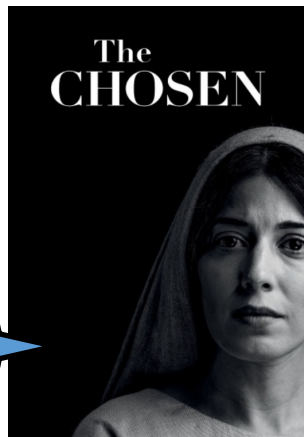
