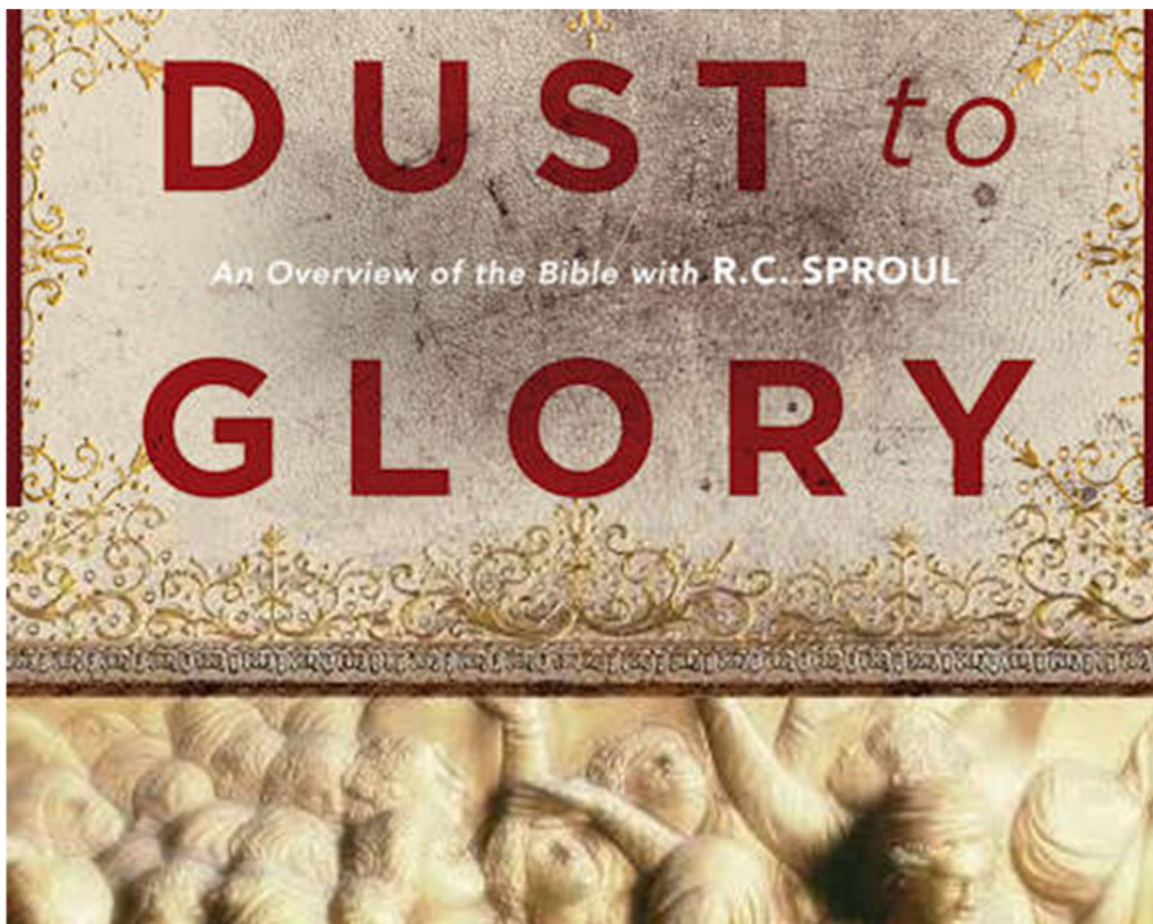

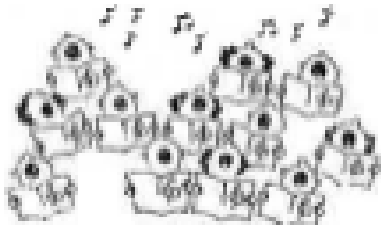

Dear Choristers and Music Lovers -

I am writing to invite you to add your voice to our tenth annual Centre Region Ecumenical Choir - a mixed choir made up of people from diverse backgrounds, abilities and traditions - to help bring a great masterwork of music to life on April 3. The choir, which will consist of approximately 40 singers, will present the choral work *Seven Last Words*, by Michael John Trotta, for choir and 14 instrumentalists, including strings, winds, brass, harp and timpani. The masterwork was premiered at Carnegie Hall in May 2017 and is scored for SATB choir (with some sectional divisions). We will also sing Howard Goodall's *The Lord is My Shepherd* from *The Vicar of Dibley*, a short piece of hope; *The Bells of Grace* will provide prelude music and bridge the two choral pieces. Please consider lending your voice to the choir!

Our 2019 concert will be 2 weeks before Easter, on Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at 7:00 pm at Grace Lutheran (Easter is April 21). The concert will last one hour. Rehearsals will be on Sunday afternoons starting February 24 from 2-4 pm in our sanctuary. Choristers of all backgrounds are welcome to join us on this musical and faith journey. There are no auditions, although choral experience or music reading skills are helpful. Singers should attend at least four of the six rehearsals; one make-up will be offered. The March 31 dress rehearsal will be from 1:30-3:30 to enable instrumentalists to honor a concert call that afternoon; it will be the only rehearsal with instrumentalists.

This is an AMAZING piece of music ... the composer engraves Jesus' last utterances onto our hearts with incredible harmonies, rhythms, and tender singing.
