Thank you for your generous donation of Quilts and Kits for LWR's distribution overseas. These gifts of your hearts and hands are beautiful expressions of God's grace and love to people all around the world. Your care and compassion makes it possible for families and communities to keep themselves healthy, warm, educated, and employed.

In April and May, the people of Nepal were shaken by two earthquakes. Nearly 9,000 people died, more than 20,000 people were injured, and 602,254 homes were destroyed. Reconstruction will take time, and it will be a long while before life feels steady again for our neighbors in Nepal. LWR has been assisting on the ground in Nepal in the months since the earthquakes and your gifts have made a tangible difference.
