change most severely. For the last 7 years, we have had a group of intrepid cyclists pedal from State College, and now also Philadelphia to Washington D.C. as a public display of our commitment and in order to meet our elected officials on Capitol Hill.

This year, the number of riders will grow and again start in State College or Philadelphia, riding from May 10-15, 2019. We would like to make the experience available to fit riders who are willing to help fundraise for the trip, train for the bike ride, and speak their convictions to their federal legislators.
