

Church Organist Part time

Purpose: To provide organ and piano music for worship services and other church functions including wedding and funerals

Education, Skills and Ability: Organist will display a professional level of musical talent from training and experience, having a thorough knowledge of the congregation's worship services and a theological understanding of church music. The organist will be able to communicate well with the pastor, minister of music and church members.

Job Performance Requirements:

1. Provide organ music in a professional manner for all worship services and all seasonal and special services, including but not limited to Christmas, Easter and Palm Sunday.

2. Facilitate the congregation to sing and worship through the excellent execution of hymns and liturgy.

3. Encourage the musical talents and participation of members of the congregation through organizing and coordinating special musical offerings, including soloists, instrumentalists, and small ensembles in cooperation with the pastor and minister of music.

4. Provide special music as needed, especially for summer services, but also throughout the year.

5. Arrange for qualified substitute or pianist when absent for church services.

6. Share accompanist work for choirs.

7. Option to provide organ music for weddings and funerals and be permitted to receive additional compensation from the parties involved.

8. Oversee a regular schedule of organ and piano service maintenance, with a qualified technician.
