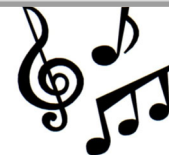

Adult Choir and Bell Choir begin meeting on Thursday, September 5, 7 pm


Monday Night Bible Study will resume on September 9, 7 pm
