From 1558 to 1829 (271 years) people in England were not allowed to practice their faith openly. During this era someone wrote "The Twelve Days of Christmas" as a kind of secret catechism that could be sung in public without risk of persecution. The song has two levels of interpretation; the surface meaning plus a hidden meaning known only to members of the church.

Each stanza in the carol is a code word for a spiritual reality to the Christian faith.

- 1. The partridge in a pear tree is Jesus Christ.
- 2. The two turtle doves are the Old and New Testaments.
- 3. Three French hens stand for faith, hope and love.
- 4. The four calling birds are the four Gospels.
- 5. The five gold rings recall the Torah (Law) the first five books of the Old Testament.
- 6. The six geese a-laying stands for the six days of creation.
- 7. Seven swans a -swimming represent the sevenfold gifts of the Spirit.
- 8. Eight maids a-milking are the eight beatitudes.
- 9. Nine ladies dancing are the nine fruits of the Spirit.
- 10. The ten lords a-leaping are the ten commandments
- 11. Eleven pipers piping stands for the eleven faithful disciples.
- 12. Twelve drummers drumming symbolize the 12 points of belief in the Apostles Creed

There you have it, the hidden meaning of the song and the secret behind it. So throughout this Advent season when you here this carol, enjoy and have fun. Now you know the deeper meaning of the carol. Jesus is the partridge in the pear tree.
