As was mentioned in last week's Piper, we are going to restart the annual Yard Sale. The sale itself is Saturday, May 13th, but during the preceding week we will be setting up, taking donations, and putting them in their respective rooms. The signup sheet are in the hall outside Fellowship Hall. Please sign up and make sure you give your contact information. This is a congregational ministry, and we need as much help as you can give.

We are titling this Yard Sale 2.0 as we are going to be doing things a little different this year. The first is: donation boxes in each room. When you drop off donations, please look for the proper donation box and put your donation in it. This will speed up the processing of your donations. Second is: we are not reusing plastic bags that donation are dropped off in, so we need clean garbage bags full of clean, dry grocery bags.

Finally, on the day of the sale, we will not be having cashiers in each room. There will be one centralized checkout at the front doors. This will avoid guests having to pay at each room and give them more of a chance to shop. This also limits the number of times things are touched.

Lastly, please review the list that was in last week's Piper newsletter of items we can and can-

not accept. The American Rescue Workers charity that picks up items we don't' sell has limited the items they will accept. They have difficulty reselling them or even finding storage space for them. If we get items that they will not take, Trinity will have to bear the cost of disposal, so please pay attention to the list. It was in last week's Piper and is also posted on the Fellowship Hall doors.
