From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Beloved of God,

Last weekend we read from the Gospel of Matthew, 14th chapter: "When Jesus heard what had happened [the execution of John the Baptizer], he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns. When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick."

It is not clear if Jesus had sufficient time to grieve not only the death of John but also to grieve his own coming demise. We are just told that when he returned from solitude, he encountered the crowds for which he had compassion, spending the rest of that day healing the sick. Despite the death of a loved one, life continues moving onward.

Even today, life moves onward, whether or not we are ready for whatever will be coming next. I am aware of this reality of life as the summer months begin winding down and I find myself looking ahead to the resumption of our fall ministries along with reclaiming some programming that has been suspended due to the pandemic. Here are a few for your information:

CHOIR – Plans are underway for us to resurrect our church choir. With Jiyoon at the piano and organ, Graham Sanders has agreed to come on staff to direct the choir.
