It is a comprehensive sexual violence education initiative for the 60+ age community, focusing on the promotion of healthy social norms and the creation of protective environments for this specific age group. Over the course of 4 sessions, you will learn about:

Recognizing Sexual Violence

Learn about the prevalence of sexual violence, what it is, and how to identify and recognize the signs of sexual violence.

Creating Safe Spaces

Learn about boundaries, what they are, how to set them, and how to communicate them with others.

Bystander Intervention

Learn how to be an active bystander and ways you can safely intervene in a variety of situations.

Reporting and Resources

Learn what to do if someone discloses an act of sexual violence to you, how to support them, and available resources.

His most recent book, *The One Body of Christ in a Quantum Age*, published in 2024, explores the relationship between spirituality and contemporary science.
