

Why is it called "HOLDEN EVENING PRAYER"?

It's called this because during the winter in 1985-1986 Marty Haugen served his musical residency in Holden Village. Holden Village, located in Washington State's North Cascades Mountains was originally a copper mining town. With its isolated location, breathtaking scenery, and a predominately Lutheran faith, Holden Village became a popular educational retreat. Here, Haugen was tasked to create a Vesper Service, thus the "Holden Evening Prayer". Within 2 years the service became popular and was adapted worldwide. Today, Holden Village is world renowned as a retreat center for all faiths, race and ethnicity.
